RULES

1. SHORT TITLE:

These Rules shall be called by the A.P. Marketing Subordinate Service Rules .1999

((2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.)

2. CONSTITUION

This service shall consist of the following categories of posts, namely:-

CLASS- A:

- CATEGORY (1) : Senior Marketing Assistant including senior Marketing Superintendent. Grading Supervisor Grade. I and Price Reporter Grade. I
- CATEGORY (2) : Statistical Assistant
- CATEGORY (3) : Junior Marketing Assistant Including Grading Supervisor , Grade, II, Price Reporter, Grade II and Junior Market Superintendent.
- CATEGORY (4) : Computer
- CATEGORY (5) : Recorder

CLASS B:

CATEGORY (1) : Chemist
CATEGORY (2) : Junior Chemist
CATEGORY (3) : Skilled Operator
CATEGORY (4) : Lab Attender

CLASS C:

CATEGORY (1) : Assistant Engineer (formerly designated as Engineering- Supervisor)
CATEGORY (2) : Draughtsman, Grade.II
CATEGORY (3) : Overseer
CATEGORY (4) : Tracer
CATEGORY (5) : Maistry

CLASS D:

Artist

3. METHOD OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTING AUTHORITY

Subject to the other provision in these rules the method of appointment and appointing authority for the several classes and categories of posts shall be as mentioned in the table below:

(b) Appointments to the categories mentioned in clause (a) above other than by direct recruitment shall be made, in the order given below under each of the said categories

 2nd Vacancy : By promotion of Junior Marketing Asst

 5th Vacancy : By promotion of Junior Marketing Asst
 6th Vacancy : By promotion of Junior Marketing Asst

(ii) JUNIOR MARKETING ASSISTANS:

 2nd Vacancy : By appointment by transfer of Jr.Asst/ L.D.Steno/ Typist of the Directorate
 3rd Vacancy : By promotion of Recorder
 4th Vacancy : By appointment by transfer of Jr.Asst/ L.D.Steno/ Typist of the Directorate
 5th Vacancy : By appointment by transfer of Jr.Asst/ L.D.Steno/ Typist of the Directorate

(ii) RECORDER:

By appointment by transfer of Record Assts. /Attendance and Driers from a common seniority list of eligible candidates of the Directorate and of the Record Assts/ Attenders and Drivers of the Respective Districts, in the alternative vacancies.

Provided that notwithstanding anything contained in this rule, the seniority of a person appointed by any of the methods mentioned above, shall be governed by the provisions of General Rule 33 of the Andhra Pradesh state and Subordinate Service Rules.

4. RESERVAIONS OF APPOINTMENT

The rule of special representation (General Rule 22) shall apply to appointments by Direct Recruitment to any post of the Service

5. WOMEN RESERVATION IN APPOINTMENT:

For the purpose of Women Reservation, the same shall be governed by General Rule 22 (A) 2.

6. QUALIFICAITONS:

No person shall be eligible for appointment to the categories specified in column(1) of the table below the method specified in column(2) unless he possess the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in column(3) thereof..

He will be liable to refund to the Government the pay and allowances and any other remuneration received by him in addition to the amount spent by the Government on his training.

- (i) if he fails to serve the department for a period of three(3) years after the completion of his training, for any reason, or
- (ii) if he discontinues the training or is discharged form training course for misconduct or any other reason, or
- (iii) if he secures any other employment elsewhere than under the state Government

(c) The period of training shall count for purposes of probation, increment, leave and pension.

(d) A direct recruit shall be eligible, during the period of training for ht initial pay of the post with usual allowances admissible at the place of training.

11. TESTS

Every person appointed by direct recruitment shall pass the Departmental Test for marketing Department, within the period of probation

12. UNIT OF APPOINTMENT

For purposes of recruitment, appointment, discharge for want for vacancy, re-appointment, seniority, promotion, transfer and posting and appointment as full member to the post specified in column(2) of the table below, the unit of appointment shall be as specified against each.

7. AGE

No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he has completed 28 years of age on the first day of July, of the year in which the notification for selection is made.

8. MINIMUM SERVICE.

No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or promotion unless is an approved probationer and has put in not less than three years of service in the category from which promotion or appointment by transfer is made.

9. PROBATION

(a) Every person appointed by direct recruitment to any post shall, from the date on which he commences probation be on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years

(b) Every person appointed to any post either by promotion or by transfer(not by transfer on tenure) shall form the date on which commences his probation, be on probation for a period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years.

10. Training

(A) Every person appointed by direct recruitment to the posts of senior Marketing Assistant, Junior Marketing Assistant and Junior Chemist shall undergo, immediately after appointment a course of training for such period and as per such program and syllabus as may be prescribed by the Director Of Marketing

(B) Every person appointed by direct recruitment shall before the commencement of training execute and agreement bond that he shall serve the Department for a period of three years after the completion of training referred to in sub-rule (a);
