The following notification shall be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazettee:-

NOTIFICATION

In-exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supercession of the Ad-hoc rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.99, Education, Dated the 16th February, 1984, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the A.P. Registration of Publications Service:-

RULES

1. Short title:-

These rules may be called the “Andhra Pradesh Registration of Publications Service Rules”.

2. Constitution:-

The service shall consist of the following category of posts in the Andhra Pradesh Registration of Publications service:-

- Category: (1) -- Registration of Publications.
Category: (2) -- Assistant Registrar of Publications.

3. Method of appointment:-

Appointment to the following categories shall be made as follows:-

Category	Method of appointment
(1) Registrar of Publications	The Director of Public Libraries will be Ex-Officio Registrar of Publications.
(2) Assistant Registrar of Publications	(i) By appointment by transfer from the category of Reader, Grade-I of the Office of the Registrar of Publications. (ii) By direct recruitment if no suitable and qualified person is

available by method (i).

4. Minimum Service:

No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer unless he has put in not less than three years of service in the category from which the transfer is made.

5. Qualifications:

No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post of Assistant Registrar of Publications unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the Column (3) against each of method of appointment specified in column (2) of the Annexure to these rules.

6. Probation:

Every person appointed to the post of Assistant Registrar of Publications shall, from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period of two years, if recruited by transfer and if recruited by direct for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

7. Tests:

Every person appointed to the post of Assistant Registrar of Publications by direct recruitment shall pass the Accounts Test for Executive Officer or Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers, Part-I & II within the period of probation.
