**ORDER :**

The Government have appointed the One Man Commission to take up comprehensive examination, revision and updating the service Rules for the various posts under the State Government Accordingly the One Man Commission took up the Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal and Medical) Service of the Police Department among others. The One Man Commission after detailed discussions with all concerned, prepared the draft rules governing the Gazetted Posts in the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal and Medical) Service and forwarded them to Government for approval and issue.

2. The Government after careful examination of the draft rules prepared by the One Man Commission for Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal and Medical) Service, approve them and issue the Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal and Medical) Service as in the notification below :-

The following notification shall be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazetteed :-

**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and of all their powers hereunto enabling, and in super session of all the rules the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal and Medical) Service.

**RULES**

**1. Short Title :-**

These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal & Medical) Service Rules.

## **2. Constitution :-**

The service shall consist of the following Classes and Categories of posts in the Andhra Pradesh Police (Legal & Medical) Service.

### **CLASS-A:**

Category (1) ... Legal Advisor (Criminal Investigation, Department).

Category (2) ... Chief Law Instructor, Police Training College, Anantapur.

### **CLASS-B:**

Category (1) ... Police Medical Officer, Civil Police Lines, Amberpet.

Category (2) (a) ... Medical Officer

- (i) Andhra Pradesh Special Police Battalions.
- (ii) Police Training College, Anantapur.
- (iii) Police Hospital, Anantapur
- (iv) Police Dispensary, Police Training College, Vizianagaram.

(b) ... Coman Assistant Surgeon, Police Hospital, Civil Police Lines, Amberpet.

## **3. Method of appointment :**

Subject to the other provisions in these rules, the method of appointment and appointing authority for the several categories of posts shall be as follows :-

<b>Class &amp; Category (1)</b>	<b>Method of appointment (2)</b>
<b><u>CLASS-A:</u></b>	
1) Legal Advisor (Criminal Investigation Department)	By transfer on tenure of a Senior Assistant Public Prosecutor (formerly designated as Assistant Public Prosecutor, Grade-I or Police Prosecuting Officer of the Prosecutions Department.
2) Chief Law Instructor, Police Training College, Anantapur.	By transfer on tenure of a Senior Assistant Public Prosecutor (formerly designated as Assistant Public Prosecutor, Grade-I or Police Prosecutor, Grade-I or Police Prosecuting Officer of the Prosecutions Department.
<b><u>CLASS-B:</u></b>	
(1) Police Medical Officer, Civil Police Lines, Amberpet	After the existing Police Medical Officer vacates the posts for any reason by transfer on tenure of a Civil Surgeon of Health and Family Welfare Department.
(2) (a) Medical Officer (i) Andhra Pradesh Special Police Battalions  (ii) Police Training College, Anantapur  (iii) Police Hospital Anantapur	By transfer on tenure of Civil Assistant Surgeon from Health and Family Welfare Department.

(iv) Police Dispensary Police Training  
College, Vizianagaram

(v) Woman Assistant Surgeon, Police  
Hospital, Civil Police Lines, Amberpet.

#### **4. Period of Tenure :**

The appointment on tenure to any post in this service shall not ordinarily be for more than three years, at a time, subject to extension for a maximum period of five years.

Provided that nothing in this rule shall preclude the Government or the Director-General and Inspector-General of Police as the case may be, to repatriate the officers taken on tenure to their respective parent departments before expiry of the period of posts, if it is considered necessary in public interest.

#### **5. Transfers and Postings :**

The Director-General and Inspector-General of Police shall be the competent to effect the transfers and postings of persons in the various categories.
