NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and of all other powers hereunto enabling and in supersession of the Adhoc Rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.699, Home (Courts) Department dated 24.5.1972, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Andhra Pradesh Government Pleaders (High Court) Gazetted Establishment Service.

RULES

1. Short title and commencement :

(1) These rules may be called the Andhra Pradesh Government Pleaders (High Court) Gazetted Officers Establishment Service Rules, 1992.

2. Constitution :

The Service shall consist of the following categories of posts in the Andhra Pradesh Government Pleaders ‘ (High Court) Gazetted Establishment Service :

Category	(1)	:	Special Officer
Category	(2)	:	Secretary.

3. Methods of appointment and appointing authority :

Subject to the other provisions in these rules, the method of appointment and appointing authority for the categories of Special Officer and Secretary shall be as follows :

Category	Method of Appointment	Appointing Authority
(1)	(2)	(3)
1. Special Officer.	By transfer on tenure basis of a Sub-Judge of the A.P. Judicial Service or a Deputy Secretary to Government in the Law Department of the A.P. Secretariat.	Government
2. Secretary	(i) By transfer on tenure basis of a District Munsif of the Judicial Service or by transfer from the category of Section Officer in the A.P. Secretariat in Class XXVIII of the A.P. General Service. (ii) If no Section Officer is available by transfer on tenure basis of Sheristader of the A.P. Judicial Ministerial Service on his own scale of pay.	-do- Government.

4. Minimum Service :

No person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer on tenure basis unless he is an approved probationer and has put in not less than three years of service in the category from which transfer basis is to be made.

5. Qualifications :

No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post of Secretary unless he possesses a Bachelor's degree in Law from any University in India established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, Provincial Act or a State Act or the Institutions recognized by the University Grants Commission or an equivalent qualification.

6. Special qualifications :

Every person appointed to the post shall pass the Accounts Test for Executive Officers within the period of probation.

Provided that a person who has already passed Parts I and II of the Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers shall not be required to pass the Accounts Test for Executive Officers.
